2. Introduction of 2017 Parent Council positions and committees

• Parent Council Positions

- Chairs: make agendas, run meetings, work with Principal and Vice Principal on mission statements for school, school statement of needs, talk about class assignments, work to facilitate an environment of growth for students and build relationships with teachers
- o **Treasurer:** track fundraising across the school by SoFun committee (e.g. Pizza day, etc); write cheques for reimbursement, tabulate results throughout the year and do a financial report-out at end of year

- o Communications & Website: manage Humbercrest communications to parents and Humbercrest website
- Ward 7 Rep: attend Ward 7 meetings with Superintendents of education (and representatives of various Board-wide Committees) and do a report out to Parent Council. If there are issues at the Board, that impact Humbercrest School, ward 7 rep facilitates conversation and debate with Parent Council and does report back to Ward 7 meetings

Committee Overview

- SoFun: is a committee of parent volunteers at Humbercrest whose purpose is to present fun, social events
 and to raise funds for materials and programs that directly benefit all students
- o Environmental & Sustainability Committee: exists to promote environmental consciousness, and Earth stewardship, in the school community by supporting students, staff and parents/caregivers in making sustainable choices in their daily activities at school and home. The goal of this committee is to work with the school community, including teachers, the school administration, as well as relevant clubs and committees, in encouraging reduction of the school's environmental footprint, providing environmental and ecological learning opportunities for the students and supporting them in achieving Platinum Eco-Schools status.
- Playground improvement group: coming to close for 2017/2018
- o **STEM:** morphed into more of a showcase



- Allergy Committee: bring allergy consciousness to the fore across Humbercrest School and make the environment safer (teachers, parents, students)
- o French/English Collaboration: drive increased collaboration across the English/French streams
- Caring & Safe Schools Committee: includes a broad spectrum of activities including the Drop Zone Program;
 looks at inclusiveness and making sure school climate is safe and caring
- o Teacher Representative: represents teacher voices and perspective at Parent Council
- o Community Representative: represents and acts as liaison with community and Humbercrest
- o Support Staff Representative: represents support staff voices and perspective at Parent Council
- o YMCA Representative: represents YMCA at Parent Council

4. Principal/Vice-Principal's Report

Principal Ann Perez welcomed the group and provided an update:

• Schoolyard improvement: everyone is embracing and loving the new playground. More painting scheduled for this weekend, by next week everything will be done. The children take off their shoes, walk around like it's a carpet, roll around, play gymnastics, football and soccer. More equipment to be purchased and storage unit being put in on the field. Humbercrest also bought soccer nets that will be put up in the near future



- Allergy committee: kicked off high- impact campaign in early September that was widely embraced by all. Overall success and raised awareness at assemblies; children were totally engaged and interested. Staff were really engaged. Overall, Humbercrest is ahead of the game
- Terry Fox: highly successful campaign to support the foundation. Humbercrest started off with a Toonie for Terry with a goal of raising \$1000 and we raised over \$4000. Each class did something in terms of walk, run and learned a lot about the cause
- Cross Country: takes place tomorrow, over 200 participants
- Coaching/Teams: starting up
- New Teachers: settling in and taking on coaching responsibilities
- Curriculum night: strong feedback on successful event
- EQAO Results:
 - English grade 3 writes reading, writing and math (total of 6 hours over 1.5 weeks). (note English grade 3 cohort is very small if they don't write, they get zero and are counted which brings the overall score down).
 - o French grade 3 write math only in French
 - o grade 6 write reading, writing and math French and English write in English.
 - o across the province results were down in Math
 - o for Humbercrest grade 3 results were down over last year in in reading, writing and math
 - o for Grade 6 the results were consistent with last year (only slightly down)
 - o as a staff, they'll be looking very closely at the data to understand where it is the students are falling down and what we can do to build up the skills
 - Next step: Ann to do report out at next Parent Council meeting on what they've learned from analyzing
 the results and what action plans and practices will be implemented to close the gaps

Vice Principal Shauna Davidson welcomed the group and provided an update:

- Strong start to the year
- Grade 5 music: integrated French and English

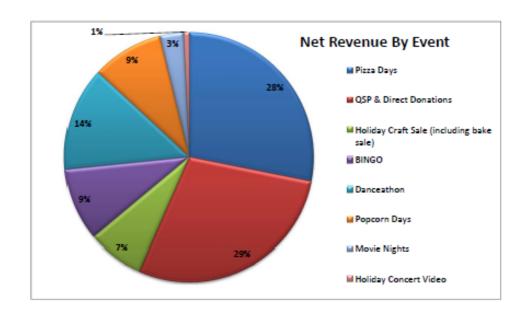
- online magazines and gifts, Humbercrest gets discounted rate and a portion of sales
